## ***AN ACT CONCERNING A STATE SONG OF REMEMBRANCE.***

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 Section 1. (NEW) (*Effective from passage*) The song "Taps", composed
- 2 by Daniel Butterfield, shall be the state song of remembrance.
