House Bill No. 6225

House of Representatives, March 22, 2011

The Committee on Human Services reported through REP. TERCYAK of the 26th Dist., Chairperson of the Committee on the part of the House, that the bill ought to pass.

AN ACT REQUIRING A RESULTS-BASED ACCOUNTABILITY REPORT CARD ON OUT-OF-STATE RESIDENTIAL TREATMENT OF CHILDREN.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 Section 1. (*Effective from passage*) Not later than February 1, 2012, the
2 Commissioner of Children and Families, using the format prescribed
3 by the results-based accountability subcommittee of the joint standing
4 committee of the General Assembly having cognizance of matters
5 relating to appropriations and the budgets of state agencies, shall
6 submit a results-based accountability report card on the Department of
7 Children and Families' placement of children in out-of-state residential
8 treatment facilities to the select committee of the General Assembly
9 having cognizance of matters relating to children, in accordance with
10 the provisions of section 11-4a of the general statutes. Such report card
11 shall include, but not be limited to, measures of (1) case management,
12 (2) the cost of placement, (3) the number of children placed in such
13 facilities, and (4) transition, support and after care services provided to
14 children leaving such facilities.
