The Committee on Government Administration and Elections reported through REP. MORIN of the 28th Dist., Chairperson of the Committee on the part of the House, that the substitute bill ought to pass.

AN ACT CONCERNING SMALL CONTRACTOR AND MINORITY BUSINESS ENTERPRISE SET ASIDE PROGRAMS IN THE METROPOLITAN DISTRICT COMMISSION.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 Section 1. Section 39 of number 511 of the special acts of 1929, as
2 amended by special act 80-14, special act 90-14 and special act 08-09, is
3 amended to read as follows (*Effective from passage*):

4 (g) The district may waive the provisions of subsection (b) of this
5 section to apply, by regulation or ordinance, the procedures described
6 in the Federal Acquisition Regulation System, as amended, to
7 implement construction delivery systems, acquisition policies and
8 procedures, or to increase contract participation, including contracts
9 for the procurement of goods or services, regardless of the source of
10 funding for such goods or services, by small contractors, minority
11 business enterprises and businesses located in member municipalities
12 of the district.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:
