**AN ACT CONCERNING A TECHNICAL CHANGE TO STATUTES GOVERNING THE DEPARTMENT OF EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT AND HOMELAND SECURITY.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 Section 1. Section 28-17 of the general statutes is repealed and the  
2 following is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective October 1, 2011*):

3 No employee shall be discharged because he or she is a member of  
4 any organization engaged in civil preparedness or because he or she is  
5 eligible for induction into the armed forces of the United States.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:
