The Committee on Higher Education and Employment Advancement reported through SEN. BYE of the 5th Dist., Chairperson of the Committee on the part of the Senate, that the bill ought to pass.

AN ACT CONCERNING CONNECTICUT'S MANUFACTURING AND TECHNOLOGY WORKFORCE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 Section 1. (*Effective from passage*) The Department of Higher
2 Education shall study issues concerning Connecticut's manufacturing
3 and technology workforce. Not later than January 1, 2012, the
4 Commissioner of Higher Education shall report on such study to the
5 joint standing committee of the General Assembly having cognizance
6 of matters relating to higher education and employment advancement
7 in accordance with the provisions of section 11-4a of the general
8 statutes.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:
