**HB 6559      “An Act Concerning a Municipal Option to Send Municipal Tax Bills Via Electronic Mail”**

HB 6559 would allow towns and cities, at their discretion and only with the consent of individual taxpayers, to disburse municipal tax bills electronically (i.e. via e-mail).

CCM **supports HB 6559** as a reasonable option for municipalities. This bill would allow towns the necessary flexibility to decide which method of sending local tax bills is preferable for their taxpayers.

CCM respectfully urges the Committee to **favorably report HB 6559.**
