



Good Morning , I respectfully submit the following as testimony in favor of our Governor's Tax Budget Proposal. Thank You William McGirr 131 Highline Trail Stamford Ct, 06902

I have read as much as possible of our Governors plan, It is well thought out spreads the revenue needs over many areas., focuses on job creation, protects local services for those in need , health & financial, & actually increases aid to cities & towns. Provide over \$1billion in capital investments in our States transportation infra-structure, \$130 million in support of affordable housing projects, The recession has cost our state a loss of over 100000 jobs,the budget proposes increasing the amount business can use of their tax credit from current 70% to 100% by way of a \$6000 for every new job they create. ' As well taxes on cigarettes up 40 cents pack & beer + 4 cents a gallon .wine + 90 cents gallon.Yes all of us will pay a bit more ie: elimination of \$500 state home owner tax credit , Gasoline tax increase of 3 cents per gallon, from 25 to 28 cents a gallon.
