RE: Solar electricity work photovoltaic or wind generation equipment

The holder of an E-1 Unlimited contractor type license or a PV-1 Limited contractor type license may apply for a permit to install a grid-tied and non-grid tied photovoltaic system.

Such photovoltaic system consisting of photovoltaic modules wired to a grid-tied Inverter or the inverter to a service panel, and is thereby connected to the grid.

The scope of work allowed under an Unlimited contractor E-1 type license in addition to Section 20-330 (2) would include photovoltaic systems under section 20-330 (18) "Solar electricity work".

The scope of work allowed under a Limited contractor type PV-1 is limited to Solar Electric systems Section 20-330 (18) "Solar electricity work"; means the installation, erection, repair, replacement, alteration, or maintenance of photovoltaic or wind generation equipment used to distribute or store ambient energy for heat, light, power or other purposes to a point immediately inside any structure or adjacent to an end use; Connection to a load center, service panel, battery bank, inverter and final connection to the grid is also allowable to complete such installation.

Therefore it is not necessary that a Limited contractor type PV-1 contract with a second electrical contractor holding an unlimited contractor E-1 type license to perform a complete working photovoltaic system.
