I listened other hearings but never testified. I like my privacy I like to sit at home, spend time with my children and family and leave legislation to the legislators. I am appalled that I have to be here today missing work in his difficult economy, with children to raise. I am totally disgusted that *someone would propose to take thousands of dollars of my property or turn me into a* Fellow.

As a former special operations reconnaissance Marine who served five years active duty, voluntarily, I have used a weapon's to defend freedom which subsequently left me 40% disabled. I am officially testifying in opposition of Bill 1094, limiting magazine capacity. This bill takes one tragedy (in Arizona), and "plays" upon it. No one will be safer because of this bill. No criminal will ever follow it, & the Magazines will be available in other places & the internet, not to mention the state is flooded with them. The author of this bill should be ashamed of himself or herself, acting in the fashion of an extremist, preying on tragedy, for their own thwarted agenda.
