
I write to you in support of this bill and request this letter become part of the March 25, 2011 testimony regarding this bill.

The bill clarifies the interest rate for Connecticut judgments. At the present time, there is some confusion within the Superior Court if judgments should accrue interest and at what rate. This bill would eliminate that confusion by imposing a standard rule.

The judgments of all other states earn interest as well as judgments issued by Federal Courts (even Federal Courts sitting in Connecticut). Interest is compensation for money that is not paid in a timely fashion. This confusion should be resolved within Connecticut and this bill does just that.
