I am a CT resident and unable to attend the Judiciary committee public hearing in regards to SB 1094, SB 1096 & SB 1210. Please include my testimony, I have provided the email I already sent to the members of the committee.

I write to you to express my opposition, as a 29 year resident of this state, to the two proposed bills SB 1094 & SB 1096 (AN ACT BANNING LARGE CAPACITY AMMUNITION MAGAZINES & AN ACT CONCERNING THE CRIMINAL POSSESSION AND SEIZURE OF FIREARM AMMUNITION). This proposed bill infringes on the 2nd Amendment rights. It will also cause great financial loss to any persons affected by its mandates not only to law abiding state residents who have spent their own hard earn money but on Connecticut state gun shop owners who will have to forfeit inventory and sales as well as manufacturers who employ hundreds of CT residents.
