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Dear Select Committee on Children:

I am testifying in favor of the mandated mediation bill No. 5815. I object to the testimony of Attorney Sharon Wicks Dornfeld and judge Lynda B. Munro as they are part of the systemic corrupt court system that is denying good fathers like myself from having custody of our children. Judge Munro sits on the Family Commission and the Child Support Guidelines Commission. Both Attorney Attorney and judge Munro have Civil Rights actions pending against them. I have a complaint against attorney Dornfeld for disability discrimination with the D.O.J. and another father has a multi million dollar suit against judge Munro. Attorney Dornfeld has a self -serving interest in keeping fathers from getting custody as she is frequently appointed AMC/GAL by Danbury Family Court judges and appears to be anti-father.

Passage of this bill would protect children from a controlling parent who isn't willing to give equal time to the other parent. Family Court Service officers are mostly biased against fathers in regards to child custody. They are part of this Corrupt Family Court System that is biased against men being the full time care givers of their children. Passage of this Bill would level the playing field. I have had many fathers complain to me of the bias of FRO's and Family Court judges especially from Danbury and Middletown where judge Munro presides. Judge Munro is unwilling to bring any sanctions against women who interfere with a father's visitation orders but is willing to incarcerate any father who is behind in child support. My ex-wife refused to go to an out of court mediator and before our divorce she refused to go to marriage counseling with me. I don't have any faith in court mediators being unbiased. I am now an adoptive parent of my two step son's yet I can't get custody of my own biological son. Why is that ?
