**AN ACT CONCERNING TRANSPORTATION AND TUITION COSTS OF STUDENTS WHOSE HEALTH CONDITION REQUIRES THEM TO ATTEND ANOTHER SCHOOL.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That title 10 of the general statutes be amended to require local or
- 2 regional boards of education to be responsible for the transportation
- 3 and tuition costs of a student, who is otherwise under the jurisdiction
- 4 of such board, to attend an alternate school in the district or a school in
- 5 another district due to health concerns of the student, provided the
- 6 doctor of such student certifies that continual attendance of the student
- 7 at the current school poses immediate and long-term health risks.

**Statement of Purpose:**

To safeguard the health of a child with a medical condition by having them attend a school that is most appropriate for such child's health condition.
