AN ACT CONCERNING IMPROVED PATIENT ACCESS TO BLOOD TEST RESULTS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That section 20-7c of the general statutes be amended to provide
- 2 that in those cases where a patient is routinely required to undergo
- 3 blood testing, the patient's health care provider may issue a single
- 4 authorization to the facility conducting such testing that allows the
- 5 facility to directly communicate all blood test results to the patient.

Statement of Purpose:

To provide patients who are routinely required to undergo blood testing with the ability to directly access the test results without need to obtain an authorization from the health care provider.
