**AN ACT CONCERNING THE POSTHUMOUS AWARD OF RIBBONS
AND MEDALS TO VETERANS FOR SERVICE IN TIME OF WAR.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That section 27-73e of the general statutes be amended to provide
- 2 that the award of a ribbon and medal to each veteran who served in
- 3 time of war, as described in said section, may be made posthumously
- 4 regardless of the date of death of such veteran.

Statement of Purpose:

To allow the Adjutant General to make posthumous awards of ribbons and medals to all veterans who served in time of war.
