AN ACT CONCERNING PROPERTY TAX EXEMPTIONS FOR COLD WAR VETERANS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 That chapter 506 of the general statutes be amended to define "Cold
2 War veteran" as any person who served in the United States Army,
3 Navy, Marine Corp, Coast Guard and Air Force in full-time, active
4 service, other than training, for a period of more than one year, during
5 the period beginning on September 2, 1945, and ending on December
6 26, 1991, who was honorably discharged and awarded a Cold War
7 Recognition Certificate, and that section 12-81 of the general statutes be
8 amended to allow municipalities the option of providing such Cold
9 War veterans a property tax exemption.

Statement of Purpose:

To allow municipalities the option of providing a property tax exemption to Cold War veterans.
