**AN ACT CONCERNING AN EXEMPTION FROM THE RACIAL
IMBALANCE LAW.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General
Assembly convened:

- 1 That sections 10-226a to 10-226e, inclusive, of the general statutes be
- 2 amended to provide an exemption from the provisions of said sections
- 3 for any local or regional board of education that demonstrate to the
- 4 State Board of Education that such board of education has made and
- 5 will continue to make a good-faith effort to address the racial
- 6 imbalance that exists in a school under such board's jurisdiction.

Statement of Purpose:

To provide an exemption from the racial imbalance law for boards of
education that make efforts to address the racial imbalance in their
schools.
