**AN ACT CONCERNING THE ADMINISTRATION OF EPINEPHRINE IN EMERGENCY SITUATIONS.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That section 19a-900 of the general statutes be amended to provide
- 2 that persons age eighteen or over, who are employed in positions that
- 3 involve regular contact with the general public, may obtain a
- 4 prescription to possess epinephrine administered through a cartridge
- 5 injector for use in emergency situations, provided such persons have
- 6 successfully completed a training program approved by the
- 7 Department of Public Health.

**Statement of Purpose:**

To permit certain persons age eighteen or over to obtain a prescription that allows such persons to administer epinephrine through a cartridge injector to a member of the public in an emergency situation.
