**AN ACT CONCERNING HUNTING AND FISHING LICENSE FEES FOR
OUT-OF-STATE RESIDENTS.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to set hunting and fishing
- 2 license fees for out-of-state residents at an amount equal to the amount
- 3 that such person's home state charges for an out-of-state resident
- 4 hunting or fishing license provided such amount shall not be less than
- 5 the amount that a resident of this state pays for a hunting or fishing
- 6 license.

Statement of Purpose:

To create parity between the hunting and fishing license fees paid by out-of-state residents to this state and the hunting and fishing license fees that Connecticut residents are required to pay in other states.
