**AN ACT REQUIRING CERTAIN DOCUMENTATION FOR THE SALE OF
A LAW ENFORCEMENT BADGE.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General
Assembly convened:

- 1 That section 53-341a of the general statutes be amended to require
- 2 that any person, firm or corporation selling or offering for sale a badge
- 3 that identifies the wearer as holding a specific office, title or position
- 4 with a state or local government or the federal government must
- 5 obtain from the person a letter signed by the commissioner of the state
- 6 or local government or federal government entity encompassing the
- 7 office, title or position before completing the sale.

Statement of Purpose:

To prevent nonlaw enforcement officials from purchasing law
enforcement badges.
