**AN ACT PROVIDING FREE ADMISSION TO STATE PARKS AND FORESTS FOR STATE RESIDENTS WHO SERVE IN THE MILITARY.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to provide free admission to
- 2 any state park or forest recreational area for any state resident who
- 3 presents a valid military identification card indicating service in the
- 4 United States Army, Navy, Marine Corps, Coast Guard, Air Force or
- 5 any reserve component thereof, including the Connecticut National
- 6 Guard.

**Statement of Purpose:**

To recognize those who serve in the military by providing free admission to any state park or forest recreational area for any state resident who presents a valid military identification card.
