**AN ACT CONFERRING THE BENEFITS OF AN ENTERPRISE ZONE  
ON PARTS OF THE TOWN OF PLAINVILLE AND THE CITY OF  
BRISTOL.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General  
Assembly convened:

1 That subsection (b) of section 32-41s of the general statutes be  
2 amended to add (1) fifty-three acres of property zoned Technology  
3 Park within census tract 420700, block 9000 in the Town of Plainville,  
4 (2) forty acres of raw land zoned Restricted Industrial within census  
5 tract 420400, block group 1000 in the town of Plainville, (3) thirty-five  
6 acres of raw land zoned Restricted Industrial within census tract  
7 420500, block 3000 in the town of Plainville, and (4) census tracts  
8 09003404061 and 09003404054 in the city of Bristol to the list of those  
9 census blocks, census block groups and census tracts in which eligible  
10 businesses and eligible commercial property are entitled to the same  
11 benefits and subject to the same conditions as enterprise zones.

***Statement of Purpose:***

To allow certain areas of Plainville and Bristol to support the type of development targeted by subsection (b) of section 32-41s of the general statutes and to give them greater flexibility in siting new bioscience industries.
