***AN ACT CONCERNING IN-STATE TUITION.***

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General  
Assembly convened:

- 1 That section 10a-29 of the general statutes be amended to allow the
- 2 children of immigrants residing in the state and who have graduated
- 3 from a public high school in the state to attend the public institutions
- 4 of higher education as in-state students for tuition purposes.

***Statement of Purpose:***

To increase access to postsecondary education for immigrant children  
who reside in and have graduated from a public high school in  
Connecticut.
