AN ACT CONCERNING AUTOMOTIVE GLASS WORK.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to require an automotive glass
- 2 contractor holding an AG-1 license to have a general liability insurance
- 3 policy of not less than one million dollars, and to prohibit an adjuster
- 4 for an insurance company, automobile physical damage appraiser or
- 5 individual or entity that processes claims for automotive glass
- 6 replacement work from having a financial interest in a business that
- 7 installs automotive glass.

Statement of Purpose:

To require an automotive glass contractor holding an AG-1 license to have a general liability insurance coverage of not less than one million dollars, and to prevent conflicts of interest of individuals or entities that process claims for automotive glass replacement work.
