AN ACT PROHIBITING HEALTH CARE PROVIDERS FROM INCLUDING A COPY OF THE PATIENT'S DRIVER'S LICENSE IN THE PATIENT'S HEALTH CARE RECORDS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to prohibit any health care
- 2 provider licensed by the state from making and retaining a photostatic
- 3 copy of the patient's driver's license as part of the patient's record.

Statement of Purpose:

To reduce opportunities for identity theft by ensuring that a photostatic copy of a patient's driver's license is not part of the patient's health care record.
