**AN ACT REQUIRING THE PRESENCE OF CARBON MONOXIDE
DETECTORS IN ALL PUBLIC SCHOOL BUILDINGS.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That section 29-292 of the general statutes be amended to provide
- 2 that all public school buildings in the state shall be equipped with
- 3 carbon monoxide detectors and that such detectors shall be routinely
- 4 tested and inspected to ensure that they are in proper working order.

Statement of Purpose:

To require all of the state's public school buildings to be equipped with carbon monoxide detectors.
