AN ACT REQUIRING CERTAIN ALL-TERRAIN VEHICLES TO BE REGISTERED WITH THE STATE AND REQUIRING THE ESTABLISHMENT OF ALL-TERRAIN VEHICLE TRAILS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to require each all-terrain
- 2 vehicle to annually be registered with the state, except if such vehicle is
- 3 used solely on the property of the owner of such vehicle, and to
- 4 require such annual registration fee of thirty dollars to be used by the
- 5 Department of Environmental Protection to maintain all-terrain vehicle
- 6 trails.

Statement of Purpose:

To require ATV's to be registered with the state and have the fees from such registration be used for all-terrain vehicle trails.
