**AN ACT CONCERNING THE CONFINEMENT AND TETHERING OF DOGS.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That section 22-350a of the general statutes be amended to provide
- 2 for the humane treatment of dogs in the confining and tethering of
- 3 such animals by prohibiting unreasonable confinement and tethering.

**Statement of Purpose:**

To strengthen current law, improve enforcement and assure public and canine welfare.
