**AN ACT CONCERNING RESTRAINING ORDERS RELATED TO
SUBSTANCE ABUSERS.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to allow a homeowner to
- 2 obtain a civil restraining order that restrains a substance abuser from
- 3 entering the homeowner's residence without requiring proof of a
- 4 continuous threat of present physical pain or physical injury.

Statement of Purpose:

To allow a homeowner to obtain a civil restraining order when a household member abuses alcohol or drugs in the homeowner's residence but does not physically threaten the homeowner.
