AN ACT CONCERNING LOTTERY WINNERS WHO ARE TAX DELINQUENT.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That chapter 226 of the general statutes be amended to require that,
- 2 when any person redeems a winning lottery ticket worth five thousand
- 3 dollars or more, the Connecticut Lottery Corporation (1) check the
- 4 name and other identifying information of such person against a state
- 5 tax delinquency database, and (2) if such person is included on the list
- 6 of obligors, withhold from the lottery winnings payable to such person
- 7 the amount of such obligation.

Statement of Purpose:

To require tax delinquents to pay any taxes owed the state before receiving lottery winnings.
