AN ACT CONCERNING THE CERTIFICATION OF CERTAIN STATE BUILDINGS AS ENERGY EFFICIENT.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to require that state buildings
- 2 that are constructed or renovated meet the standards of Leadership In
- 3 Energy and Environmental Design (LEED) to be certified at the Silver
- 4 level rather than just LEED certified.

Statement of Purpose:

To require a higher level of energy efficiency for state buildings that are constructed or renovated.
