AN ACT CONCERNING THE CLASSIFICATION OF AMERICAN SIGN LANGUAGE IN THE EDUCATION CURRICULUM.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That section 10-16b of the general statutes be amended to change the
- 2 classification of American sign language from language arts to a
- 3 foreign language.

Statement of Purpose:

To classify American sign language as a foreign language for purposes of the prescribed education curriculum.
