AN ACT CONCERNING DISSECTION CHOICE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That title 10 of the general statutes be amended to prohibit local and
- 2 regional school districts from requiring any student that raises a
- 3 conscientious objection to perform any surgical or anatomical
- 4 experiments or dissections on any animal as part of classroom
- 5 instruction, and that such local and regional school districts shall
- 6 provide alternative methods of dissection, such as simulated models,
- 7 plastic models, computer programs, images and Internet sources, that
- 8 students may perform in lieu of dissection of animals.

Statement of Purpose:

To allow students to conscientiously object to performing dissections in the classroom.
