AN ACT EXTENDING THE MINIMUM BUDGET REQUIREMENT.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 That section 10-262i of the general statutes be amended to require
2 for the fiscal years ending June 30, 2012, and June 30, 2013, that a
3 town's budgeted appropriation for education shall be not less than the
4 budgeted appropriation for education for the fiscal year ending June
5 30, 2009, provided the equalization aid grant amounts to towns,
6 pursuant to section 10-262h of the general statutes for the fiscal years
7 ending June 30, 2012, and June 30, 2013, are not less than the amounts
8 received for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2011.

Statement of Purpose:

To extend the minimum budget requirement for education for the next two fiscal years to provide continuity in educational funding.
