AN ACT CONCERNING JOBS FOR THE UNEMPLOYED.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to authorize a tax credit for
- 2 businesses that hire new employees, including former inmates, who
- 3 have been unemployed for at least sixty days. The tax credit would be
- 4 equal to up to one thousand dollars per year for up to three years for
- 5 each qualified employee hired.

Statement of Purpose:

To authorize a tax credit to encourage hiring unemployed persons, including former inmates.
