**AN ACT EXEMPTING NONPROFIT VOLUNTEER AMBULANCE SERVICES FROM STATE INSURANCE REQUIREMENTS.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That section 38a-41 of the general statutes be amended to provide
- 2 that a nonprofit ambulance service or company that provides
- 3 emergency medical services on a subscription basis shall not be
- 4 deemed to be engaged in the business of insurance if such services
- 5 were provided by such service or company to residents of a
- 6 municipality on or before January 1, 2009.

**Statement of Purpose:**

To allow a nonprofit volunteer ambulance service to provide services in the state on a subscription basis while remaining exempt from the statutory requirements of title 38a of the general statutes.
