**AN ACT REQUIRING ATTORNEYS TO MAINTAIN PROFESSIONAL LIABILITY INSURANCE.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to require any attorney
- 2 admitted to practice in this state who is engaged in the active practice
- 3 of law to maintain professional liability insurance against liability for
- 4 professional malpractice, with indemnification limits of not less than
- 5 one million dollars for one person, per occurrence, with an aggregate
- 6 of not less than three million dollars.

**Statement of Purpose:**

To require any attorney admitted to practice in this state who is engaged in the active practice of law to maintain professional liability insurance.
