AN ACT STRENGTHENING MUNICIPAL ETHICAL STANDARDS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 That the general statutes be amended to prohibit any (1) municipal
2 chief executive officer; (2) member of a municipal legislative body; (3)
3 member of a planning, zoning or combined planning and zoning
4 commission; (4) member of a board of education; (5) superintendent or
5 (6) municipal or board of education purchasing agent from receiving
6 any item exceeding one hundred dollars in value in any year from (A)
7 a firm or any employee of a firm holding or bidding on a contract with
8 such municipality or board of education, or (B) any person with a
9 matter pending before a planning, zoning or combined planning and
10 zoning commission, provided that any municipality with an ethics
11 code adopted pursuant to state law may establish more stringent
12 ethical requirements.
