AN ACT REQUIRING A MEDICAL INSTITUTION TO NOTIFY THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC HEALTH UPON A FINAL ADJUDICATION THAT AN EMPLOYEE OF THE INSTITUTION HAS BREACHED A STANDARD OF CARE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That chapter 368v of the general statutes be amended to require that
- 2 upon a final adjudication of a breach of a standard of care, the medical
- 3 institution employing the person found to have breached the standard
- 4 of care shall report the court finding to the department not later than
- 5 thirty days after the date of the finding. Upon reviewing the
- 6 adjudicatory finding, the department shall take such action as it deems
- 7 necessary.

Statement of Purpose:

To require medical institutions to notify the Department of Public Health when an employee of the institution has been finally adjudicated by a Connecticut court to have breached a duty of care.
