**AN ACT CONCERNING INCENTIVES FOR SCHOOL DISTRICTS THAT
USE RESEARCH-BASED PRACTICES FOR COMBATING SCHOOL
BULLYING.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General
Assembly convened:

- 1 That title 10 of the general statutes be amended to provide
- 2 incentives for local and regional boards of education that use research-
- 3 based practices to identify and prevent bullying and cyberbullying in
- 4 schools.

Statement of Purpose:

To provide incentives to school districts that use research-based
practices to identify and prevent bullying so as to create a safe school
environment for students.
