AN ACT REQUIRING ELECTRONIC TIME AND ATTENDANCE RECORDS FOR STATE EMPLOYEES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to require the Department of
- 2 Information Technology, in conjunction with the Comptroller, the
- 3 Commissioner of Administrative Services and the executive director of
- 4 the Joint Committee on Legislative Management, to create a
- 5 centralized electronic process for recording and transmitting all state
- 6 employee time and attendance records.

Statement of Purpose:

To streamline state government and eliminate the use of paper time records.
