**AN ACT CONCERNING ELECTRONIC PRICING SYSTEMS AND THE
SALE OF ALCOHOLIC LIQUOR.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General
Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to prohibit the sale of
- 2 alcoholic liquor using an electronic pricing system unless such system
- 3 requires the seller to verify that the purchaser is at least twenty-one
- 4 years of age and to define "electronic pricing system" as a system that
- 5 uses a universal product coding bar code scanner and cash register to
- 6 record and total a customer's purchase.

Statement of Purpose:

To require verification of a purchaser's age when alcoholic liquor is
purchased using an electronic pricing system.
