**AN ACT ESTABLISHING A COMMISSION ON THE STATUS OF PROTECTED CITIZENS.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to consolidate the
- 2 Commission on Aging, Permanent Commission on the Status of
- 3 Women, Commission on Children, African-American Affairs
- 4 Commission, Asian Pacific-American Affairs Commission and Latino
- 5 and Puerto Rican Affairs Commission into six divisions of a newly
- 6 created Commission on the Status of Protected Citizens with one
- 7 executive director and six division directors.

**Statement of Purpose:**

To find efficiency within government in order to provide better service to the citizens of the state within existing resources where such services are already being provided.
