AN ACT CONCERNING INTERLOCAL AGREEMENTS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That sections 7-148cc and 7-339a to 7-339l, inclusive, of the general
- 2 statutes be amended to (1) clarify that two or more municipalities may
- 3 enter into an interlocal agreement to jointly perform any function that
- 4 each municipality may perform separately, and (2) authorize
- 5 municipalities to adopt interlocal agreements by a vote of their
- 6 legislative body.

Statement of Purpose:

To clarify existing statutes, simplify the process for regionalization, and encourage municipalities to work together to find efficiencies and reduce the cost of delivering important public services.
