AN ACT CONCERNING LABOR CONTRACTS DURING PERIODS OF HIGH UNEMPLOYMENT.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to provide that when the
- 2 state's unemployment rate is above seven and one-half per cent, the
- 3 legislative body of any municipality may reject a contract and the
- 4 parties shall not be required to submit to mandatory binding
- 5 arbitration until such unemployment rate remains below seven and
- 6 one-half per cent for a period of not less than six months.

Statement of Purpose:

To allow the legislative body of a municipality to reject a contract without requiring mandatory binding arbitration during periods of high unemployment.
