AN ACT CONCERNING THE DUTY OF A PHARMACIST TO NOTIFY A PATIENT WHEN THE MANUFACTURER OF A PRESCRIPTION DRUG IS CHANGED.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That section 20-619 of the general statutes be amended to require a
- 2 pharmacist to provide notification to a patient when there is a new
- 3 manufacturer of the patient's brand name or generic prescription drug
- 4 medication.

Statement of Purpose:

To require pharmacists to provide patients with critical information regarding the medications they are prescribed.
