AN ACT REQUIRING REGISTRATION OF ALL FIREARMS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That section 29-33 of the general statutes be amended to (1) require
- 2 that (A) any person who purchases a firearm register the firearm
- 3 within ten days of purchase, (B) any person who purchased a firearm
- 4 prior to this statute's effective date register that firearm within ten days
- 5 of the effective date, (C) any person owning a firearm renew
- 6 registration every five years, and (D) anyone whose registered firearm
- 7 is sold, stolen or lost report such sale, theft or loss within ten days of
- 8 such event; and (2) provide that the Department of Public Safety
- 9 receive the registrations required by subdivision (1) of this section.

Statement of Purpose:

To require registration of all firearms.
