**AN ACT CONCERNING THE AUTHORITY OF SUPERINTENDENTS TO  
HIRE SUBSTITUTE TEACHERS.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General  
Assembly convened:

- 1 That section 10-145 of the general statutes be amended to eliminate
- 2 the requirement that substitute teachers hold a bachelor's degree and
- 3 to provide authority to superintendents to employ a person as
- 4 substitute teacher in the school district even if such person does not
- 5 hold a bachelor's degree.

**Statement of Purpose:**

To give superintendents the freedom to choose substitute teachers for  
their school systems.
