AN ACT CONCERNING A BAN ON TAX CREDITS TO ANY CORPORATION USING CORPORATE MONEY FOR POLITICAL OR PUBLIC POLICY ADVERTISING.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to require, as a condition of
- 2 receiving any tax credits from the state, a corporation must agree that
- 3 the corporation or any related corporate entity, or any person or entity
- 4 acting on the corporation's behalf will not use any corporate money for
- 5 television, radio, print, mail or Internet communication to influence
- 6 any election, referendum or public policy decision.

Statement of Purpose:

To ban tax credits to any corporation using corporate money for political or public policy advertising.
