AN ACT CONCERNING TAX CREDITS FOR TRANSPORTATION-SUPPORTIVE INDUSTRIES AND JOBS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to authorize tax credits to
- 2 spur the growth of home-grown or relocated industries that will
- 3 provide the goods and services needed to achieve and support
- 4 Connecticut's long-term transportation goals, assist the state's ongoing
- 5 investment in transportation improvements, create and sustain more
- 6 jobs in Connecticut and result in a greater percentage of our state
- 7 transportation funds being spent within Connecticut.

Statement of Purpose:

To establish tax credits to provide support for the state's long-term needs to improve and develop its transportation systems, including its highway system, airports, ports and rail infrastructure.
